

### Site Resources

### Infrastructure (Water & Sewer):

Wysox Municipal Authority operates the public water and sewer system. The Authority currently has excess conveyance capacity within both the water and sewer system. Towanda Municipal Authority handles the public water supply and wastewater treatment. Both systems currently have excess capacity. Currently water and sewer is available on Craftmaster Road (SR2032).

### Site Access:

Existing site access is off Craftmaster Road (SR2032). Near the intersection of Craftmaster Road and Shiner Drive.

### **Existing Terrain:**

The subject property includes open field and gravel areas. The property has been used in the past as a construction yard and processing facility. Slopes range from 0-8% and the present soil material is primarily comprised of Alton gravelly sandy loams.

### **Railroad Availability:**

There is not railroad access to this site.

### Floodplain Regions:

The southeast side of the property is located within 100-year floodplain region.

### Wetlands (NWI Review):

Potential wetlands have been identified on the property. These potential wetlands are located on the southeast side of the site.

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#### NOTES TO USERS

Boundaries of the **floodways** were computed at cross sections and interpolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic considerations with regard to requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program. Floodway widths and other pertinent floodway data are provided in the Flood Insurance Study report for this jurisdiction.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by **flood** control structures. Refer to Section 2.4 "Flood Protection Measures" of the Flood Insurance Study report for information on flood control structures for this jurisdiction.

The projection used in the preparation of this map was Pennsylvania State Plane north zone (FIPSZONE 3701). The horizontal datum was NAD 83, GRS80 spheroid. Differences in datum, spheroid, projection or State Plane zones used in the production of FIRMs for adjacent jurisdictions may result in slight positional differences in map features across jurisdiction boundaries. These differences do not affect the accuracy of the FIRM.

Flood elevations on this map are referenced to the North American Vertical Datum of 1988. These flood elevations must be compared to structure and ground elevations referenced to the same vertical datum.
